


Volunteer Role Description

Collections Volunteer





Purpose of the Role:

As a Collections Volunteer you will be working with the team to document and care for the museums unique and diverse collection. The museum looks after a collection of 80,000 objects and your role will include working with significant collections such as North Devon Pottery, Natural History, Shapland & Petter furniture and the Royal Devon Yeomanry.

As a Collections Volunteer your supervisor and main contact will be Samantha Bevan, Collection Officer.

Availability of Role:

Although the Collections Volunteer role is available throughout the year, we have currently reached capacity with this role and are unable to accept any more Collections Volunteers at this point in time. We hope to reopen this volunteering role in the near future, if you are interested in this role please contact the Collections Officer.

Main Activities:

- Cataloguing the collection and inputting data into the museum's collections database.
- Learning about and implementing the museum's policies and procedures on the care of collection.
- The re-organisation of the collections. This may include; sorting and re-boxing, conducting condition checks, and producing labels.
- Learn and use museum based skills including delicate object handling, object cleaning, moving and accessioning.
- Simple conservation and cleaning of objects, following museum procedures.
- Digitise the museum collection by scanning and photographing objects from the collection.
- Work with the Collections Officer on other curatorial tasks and projects when they arise.

Time commitment of role:

The Collections Volunteer role requires a commitment of 3.5 hours weekly either in the morning or afternoon. As the role is very popular and involves professional training we request a minimum commitment of six months.

All roles at the museum include a trial period of 25 hours to ensure the role is right for you and the museum team.
